



Read Conmigo School Impact Grant Eligibility Requirements

The Read Conmigo School Impact Grants support school- or program-wide initiatives that advance dual-language (Spanish-English) education for bilingual students at Title I elementary schools. Grant applications are accepted annually during selected dates from January to March, with grant funds distributed in May to support initiatives for the upcoming school year.

Each year, The Kemper Foundation awards up to 22 grants of \$10,000 each. These funds are intended to support school- or program-wide dual-language initiatives, including school resource and technology improvements, instructional support and professional development, and community and cultural engagement.

To be eligible for the Read Conmigo School Impact Grant, schools must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Title I public or charter elementary school serving bilingual students in one of the following locations:
 - o California: Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, or Ventura counties
 - o Florida: Broward or Miami-Dade counties
 - o **Texas:** Dallas or Hidalgo counties
- Have an established dual-language (Spanish-English) program with at least one year of implementation.
- Cannot have received a Read Conmigo School Impact Grant in the previous school year.

Read Conmigo School Impact Grant applications must be submitted by the principal. Principals:

- May submit only one application per grant cycle
- Must submit the application through the grants portal
- **Cannot** have an immediate family member employed by any of the Kemper family of companies, including Kemper Corporation, Kemper Auto, and Kemper Life.
