Euclid Avenue School (Los Angeles, CA)

With their Read Conmigo Grant, Euclid Avenue School will enhance their school library by funding 400 new Spanish-language books, flexible seating options, and signage to help students locate books.

Fremont Elementary School (Alhambra, CA)

Fremont Elementary School will utilize their Read Conmigo Grant to host a series of art and cultural history workshops on campus, in collaboration with local Latino cultural organization Plaza de la Raza, to educate students on the rich history of Latino culture.

Mar Vista School (Oxnard, CA)

Mar Vista School's Read Conmigo Grant will support five school-wide bilingual, cultural assemblies to strengthen students' sociocultural competencies.
