**The Kemper Foundation Opens 2026 Read Conmigo
School Impact Grant Applications**
New communities added as the program enters its second year

CHICAGO, January 20, 2026 — [The Kemper Foundation](http://TheKemperFoundation.org), the philanthropic partner of [Kemper Corporation](http://KemperCorporation.com), announced the opening of its 2026 [Read Conmigo School Impact Grant](http://ReadConmigoSchoolImpactGrant.org) application cycle. The program provides funding to Title I elementary schools to support dual-language (Spanish-English) educational initiatives that enhance bilingualism and biliteracy and strengthen long-term student success.

For the 2026 cycle, The Kemper Foundation will offer up to 22 grants of \$10,000 each and has expanded eligibility to include schools in Maricopa County, AZ; Harris County, TX; and Cook County, IL in addition to Greater Los Angeles, Miami, Dallas and McAllen, TX. This expansion enables the Foundation to reach more schools where it seeks to deepen its educational impact.

[The Read Conmigo School Impact Grants](http://TheReadConmigoSchoolImpactGrants.org) support a range of school or program-wide initiatives, including library enhancements, educational technology, instructional resources, and family and community engagement efforts. The flexible structure of the grants allows schools to address local needs while strengthening dual-language learning environments.
